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## Exam Fees

The application-examination fee schedule is as follows:

Anatomic pathology only	\$1800
Clinical pathology only	\$1800
Anatomic pathology portion of combined AP/CP	\$1800
Clinical pathology portion of combined AP/CP	\$1800
Anatomic pathology portion of combined AP/subspecialty	\$1800
Clinical pathology portion of combined CP/subspecialty	\$1800
Combined anatomic pathology and clinical pathology	\$2200
Subspecialty only	\$1800
Subspecialty portion of combined AP/subspecialty	\$1800
Subspecialty portion of combined CP/subspecialty	\$1800
Fee to transfer examination to a future administration (primary examinations only)	\$500
Voluntary Recertification without examination	\$1000
Voluntary Recertification with examination	\$1800
Single Certification Application Fee (available only to candidates who have been declared qualified for the combined Anatomic Pathology and Clinical Pathology examination, have been successful in one portion of the examination, and wish to relinquish their combined certification—please refer to the Single Certification Application Instructions)	\$1000

The application-examination fee includes a nonrefundable administrative fee of \$100. If the different divisions of the AP/CP and the combined primary and subspecialty examinations are taken at separate sittings, there is a separate examination fee for each sitting. If the candidate fails in the examination, admission to a repeat examination is permitted, but any reexamination must occur as described within the period of qualification (see Qualification Period for Examination). The applicant must pay the examination fee according to the current fee schedule before another examination can be taken. See Examination Dates and Deadlines.

Date assignments for all examinations are made by the ABP. If a candidate is unable to accept a date assignment for a primary examination, he/she may transfer the exam fee (minus a transfer fee of \$500) to a future administration of the examination. **Transfers cannot be made within the same examination period. Special requests for date assignments cannot be accepted.**

## Late Application Period and Fees

A late application period for examinations is now available. The late application period extends for one month past the original deadline and includes a late fee.

The late application-examination fee schedule and availability dates are as follows:

Anatomic pathology only	\$2700	January 16 – February 15, May 16 – June 15
Clinical pathology only	\$2700	January 16 – February 15, May 16 – June 15
Combined anatomic pathology and clinical pathology	\$3300	January 16 – February 15, May 16 – June 15
Subspecialty only	\$2700	May 16 – June 15

There will be no late registration period available for the August 15 deadline for the fall examinations.
